### ARE YOU CLOCKING YOUR CHILD IN/OUT EACH DAY?

We are required by DHS to keep a record of all children present each day and who brings them to school and/or picks them up. Please remember to check your child in/out each day!! If you need help using the app or checking in/out please let Ms. Amy or Ms. Norma know.

## REMINDER LATE CHARGES...

Option 1 hours are 9:00am to 2:00pm

Option 2 hours are 7:15am-5:00pm

Our late fee charge is \$3 per minute per child you are late picking up after 2pm or 5pm.

**\*These charges will be added to your next bill\***

Please call or message through the Procare app or class dojo if your child is going to be late coming to school or if you are going to be late picking up your child.

**\*\*Most of our instruction/craft time occurs in the mornings before lunch and nap. It is important to have your child(ren) here by 9 am to ensure that he/she gets that instruction time. \*\***



- Your child needs a water bottle everyday.
- Please make sure if your child has a drink in their lunch box that it is not in a container that leaks.
- No glass containers for lunches.
- Please send a coat or jacket and appropriate play shoes each day.
- Pull- ups for potty training children need to have re-attachable sides
- Don't forget to check your child(ren) in/out each day.
- **LABEL EVERYTHING** your child brings to school. Many children have the same items.


